## Monk-Gammlo's / Slippers



You need:
Yarn: Wolle Rödel Unsiversal alternative Schachenmayr Bravo (200g)
Crochet Hook 5mm, Double thread it! Size EU 38/39, UK 5-6

$d c=$ double croche $\dagger$
ss = slip stitch
ch = chain
$s t=s t i t c h$
hdc = half double crochet
sc = single crochet
Rd = round
$\mathrm{fpdc}=$ front post double crochet
bpdc = back post double crochet

## Part I

Start with magic ring: 1ch, 7sc, close round with 1ss in first ch.

## 1st Rd.:

ch2, 2 hdc in each stich. Close round with 1 ss in second ch from beginning ( $=14 \mathrm{st}+1 \mathrm{ss}$ )
2nd Rd.:
ch3, 2dc in each stitch
Close round with 1ss in third ch from beginning ( $=28 s t+1 s s$ )
3rd to 6th Rd.:
start first fpdc around the 3ch-stitches from 2nd Rd!

| 11 fpdc | $2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fbdc}$ | 10bpdc, | $2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}$ |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| (dorsum of foot | laterally | foot sole | laterally) |

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(In accordance with thinner yarn or larger foot more stitches, for example with a total of 35 stitches: Crochet $13 \mathrm{fpdc}, 3 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fbdc}, 12 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 3 \mathrm{bpdc}$.

## Part II

In 7th rd to the lateral loops (2bpdc) per an increase by a bpdc is doubled

Danach:

| 11 fpdc, | $3 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}$, | 10bpdc, | $2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 3 \mathrm{bpdc}$ |

Further 10-11 rounds without end until one arrives to the instep of the foot! (about 17 cm measured from the top to the heel-start. Please look at size chart)

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## Part III

Use of the heel portion from the sides and below the sole. In the last round before start the heel:
$3 b p d c, 2 f p d c, 10 b p d c, \quad 2 f p d c, 3 b p d c--$ End here and start heel!


For the heel in return rows with crochet 2 CH , so crochet stitches as they appear....

Back row : ch2, $2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 10 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 3 \mathrm{fpdc}$, turn

RS row: ch2, $2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 10 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpdc}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn

Back row: ch2, $2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 10 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpd}, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpd}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn

## About 3 cm from heel-ending start with decrease.

RS row:
Ch2,
$2 b p d c, 2 f p d c$
crochet $2 b p d c$ together (decrease), 6bpdc,
crochet $2 b p d c$ together (decrease),
$2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpdc}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn
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## back row:

Ch2,
$2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}$
crochet 2 fpdc together (decrease), 4 fpdc ,
crochet 2 fpdc together (decrease),
$2 b p d c, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpdc}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn

## RS row:

Ch2,
2bpdc, 2 fpdc
crochet $2 b p d c$ together (decrease), $2 b p d c$,
crochet $2 b p d c$ together (decrease),
$2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpdc}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn

## Back row:

Ch2,
$2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}$
crochet 2 fpdc together (decrease),
crochet 2 fpdc together (decrease),
$2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpdc}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn

RS row:

## Ch2,

2bpdc, 2 fpdc
crochet $2 b p d c$ together (decrease),
$2 \mathrm{fpdc}, 2 \mathrm{bpdc}, 1 \mathrm{fpdc}$ around chain stitches of previous row, turn

## Part IV

Crochet the stem.
Crochet further rounds without stage-ch and with fpdc until the desired length is reached. As a conclusion e.g. 3 rounds solid mesh, this is only the front loops of the stitch.

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
